REGISTRATION

Registration fees are the same for both at-the-park and virtual races. Donations to Fierce Freedom beyond race fees are tax deductible.

RACE FEE DISCOUNT THROUGH JULY 1:

\$15 age 12 & under, \$25 age 13-adult, \$75 family of 4+

RACE FEES AFTER JULY 1:

\$18 age 12 & under, \$28 age 13-adult, \$80 family of 4+*

Please make checks payable to Fierce Freedom.

*Family of 4+ discount applies to those living in the same household

ONLINE registration closes July 20 at midnight.

MAIL-IN registration must be postmarked by July 15.

ONSITE registration is available starting at 4:30 PM

PACKET PICKUP

There are two in-person packet pickup options for ALL race participants (for the at-the-park race and the virtual race):

- Tuesday, July 20 from 5-7 pm at the Fierce Freedom office, Altoona WI
 - On race day starting at 4:30 pm at Carson Park
- Virtual race participants have the option of having their t-shirts shipped to them for a fee if they register by July 1.

T-SHIRT GUARANTEE DEADLINE

To guarantee your t-shirt, postmark by June 29 or register online by July 1.

AWARDS

Chip timing is available for all races at the park. Runners **MUST** be chip-timed to be eligible for prizes (virtual runners will not be eligible for prizes because times cannot be verified). Prizes will be given for top finishers in each of seven age categories for the 2-mile run and the 5-mile run and in each of 3 age categories for the kids' race (ages 12 and under). Runners, walkers, and families with young children/strollers are welcome.

Prizes will be awarded to the top three individuals who raise the most money.
